

INSTRUCTIONS AFTER CEREC ONLAY TREATMENT

- You may or may not experience hypersensitivity to hot or cold temperatures for a few days or a few weeks after receiving a Cerec Onlay treatment
- In order to promote healing, the doctor may place medication on the tooth, depending on the size and depth of the cavity. This medication will help to insulate the tooth from hot and cold. Please be very careful with that certain tooth for a couple of days.
- Usually you won't have any extreme pain after receiving a Cerec Onlay, but if you do have any slight discomfort, such as minor hot or cold temperatures or sensitivity, you may take an aspirin to help relieve the pain.
- After your new permanent Cerec Onlay is in place you may need a few days to adjust to it. If you feel the bite is not correctly balanced, call our office for an appointment and we will adjust your bite.
- Regular 3-6 month check-ups are mandatory in the Cerec Onlay process in order to keep your warranty active. Proper brushing and flossing are also necessary to help you retain this restoration.
